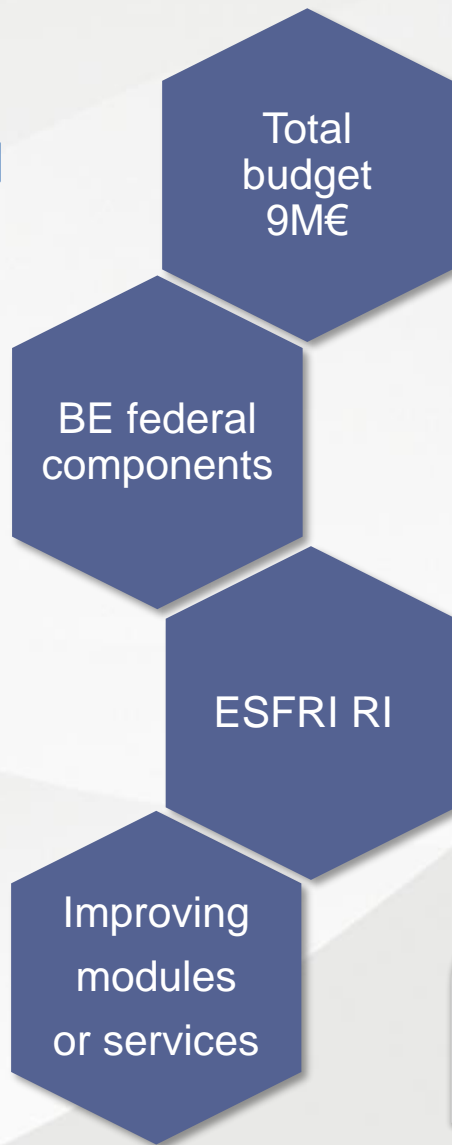

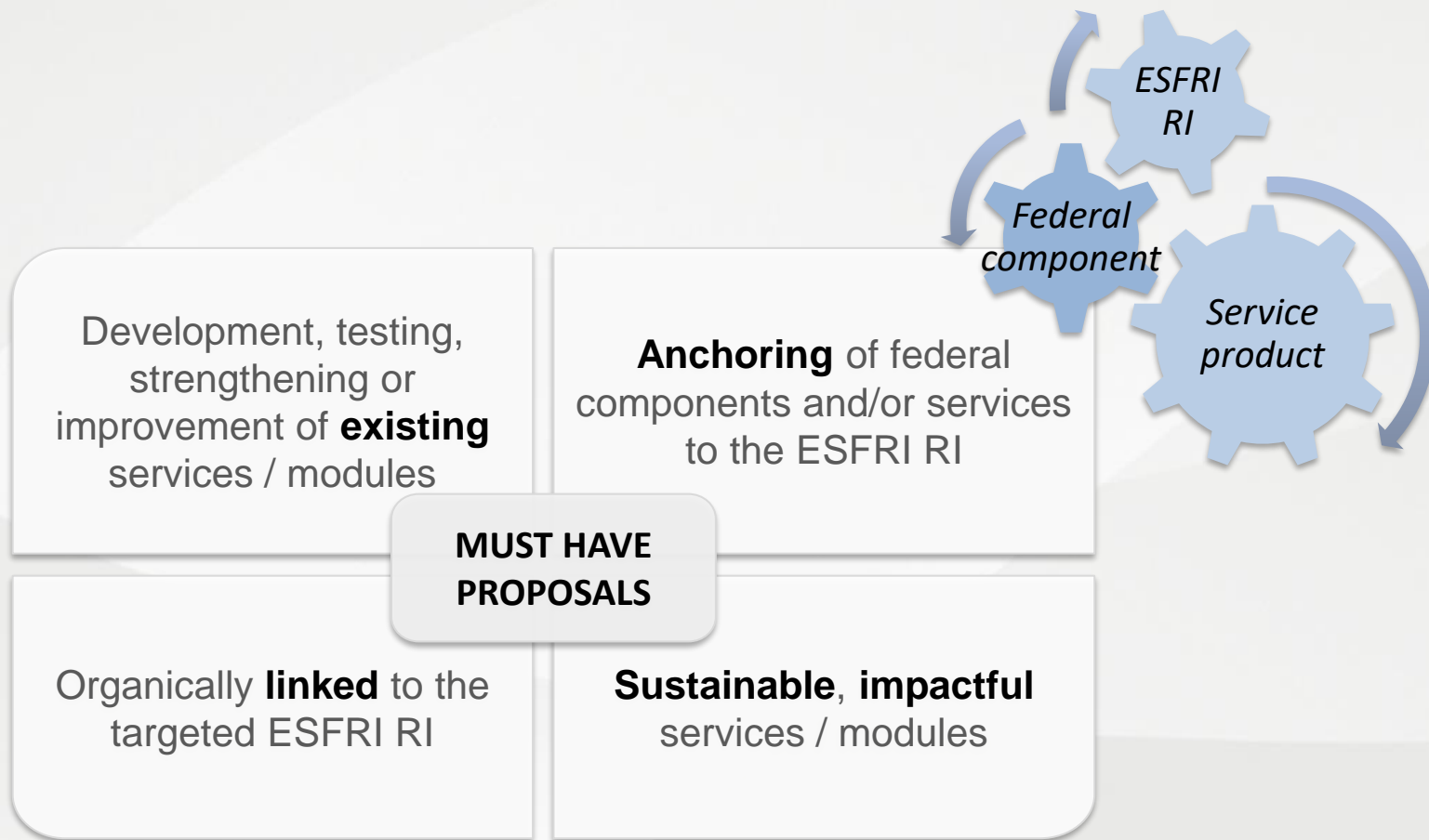

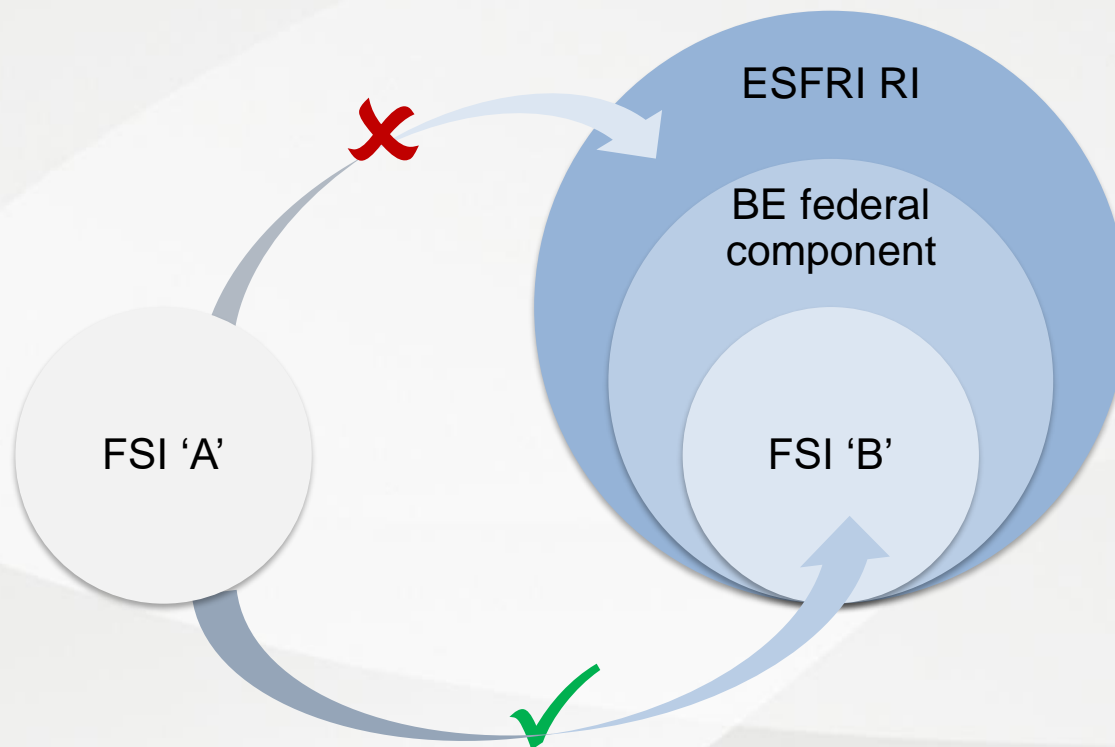

- **Non financed partners can be associated to the project** contributing with cash or in-kind e.g., Federal departments, Regional partners, International partners.



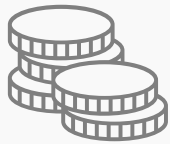

It is possible to submit a proposal addressing an ESFRI RI in which a FSI 'A' does not participate BUT there needs to be a concertation FSI (A) – FSI (B) and the support of the BE federal component

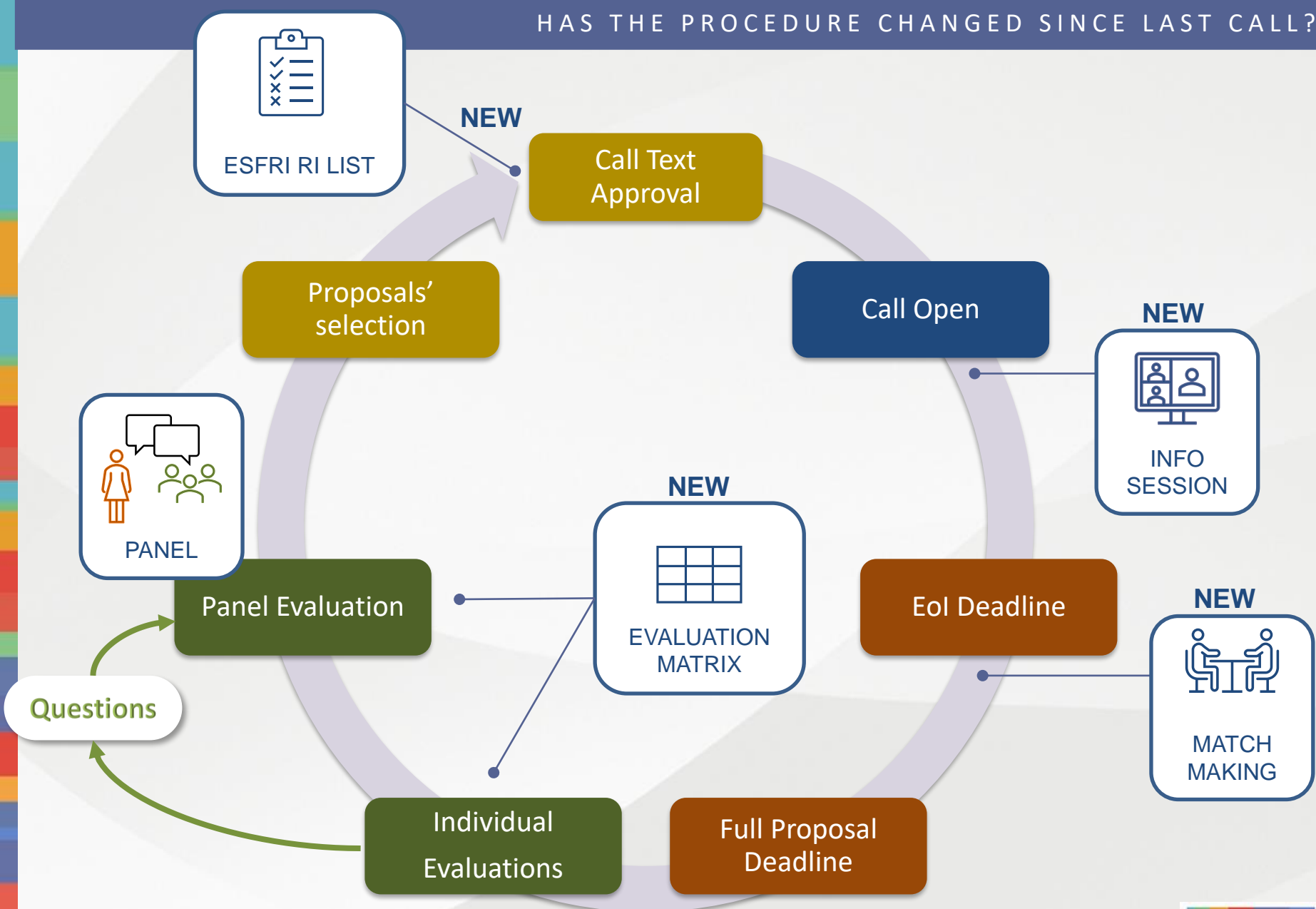
BUDGET / PROPOSAL

- Max. **400k€** single partner proposal
- Max. **750k€** +2 partners proposal
- No minimum, no typical budget

Nr of PROJECTS

6 – 8 projects

Duration of projects = 2 to 4 years

- ✓ Make better use of available resources

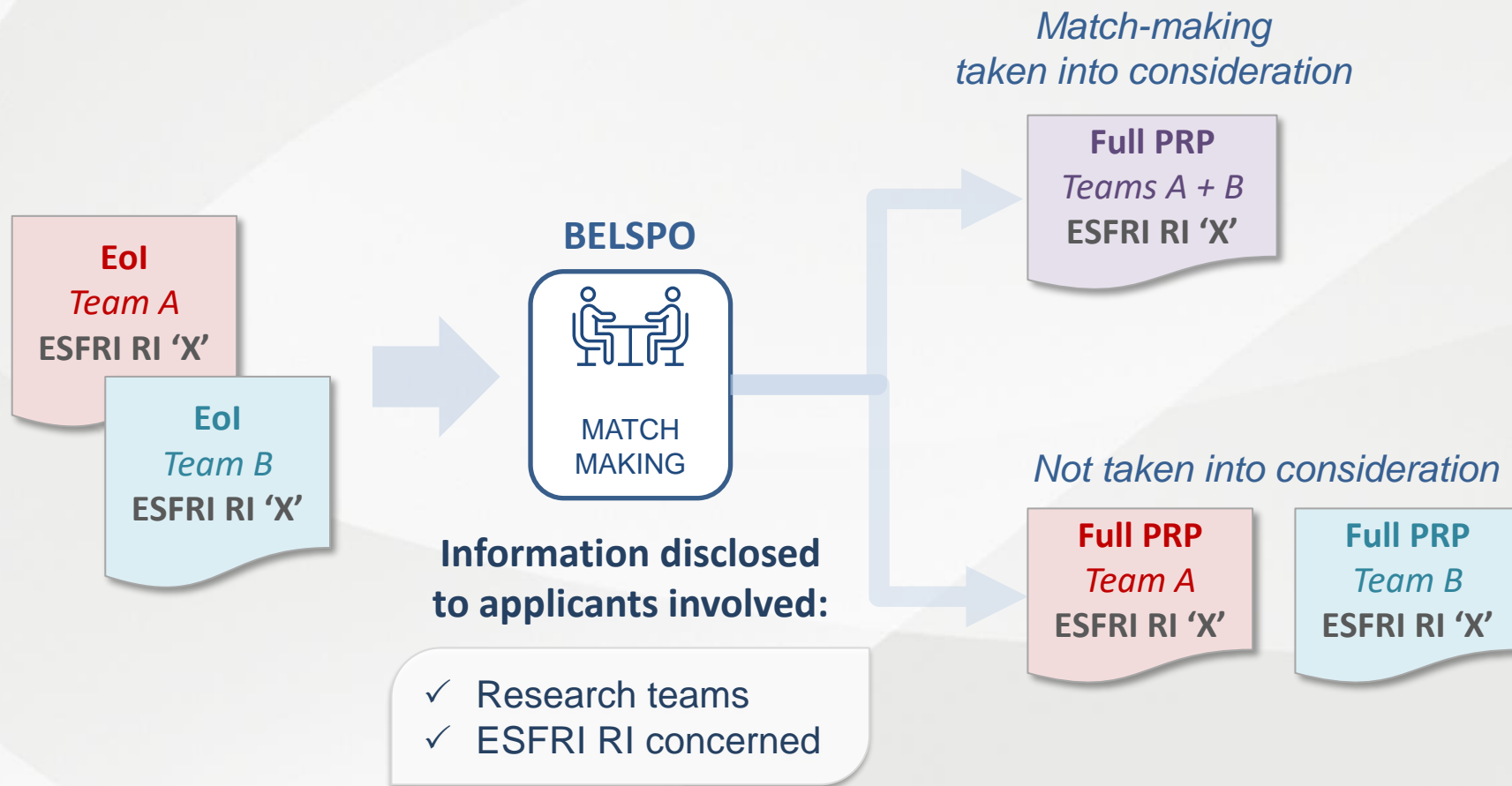
REMARKS

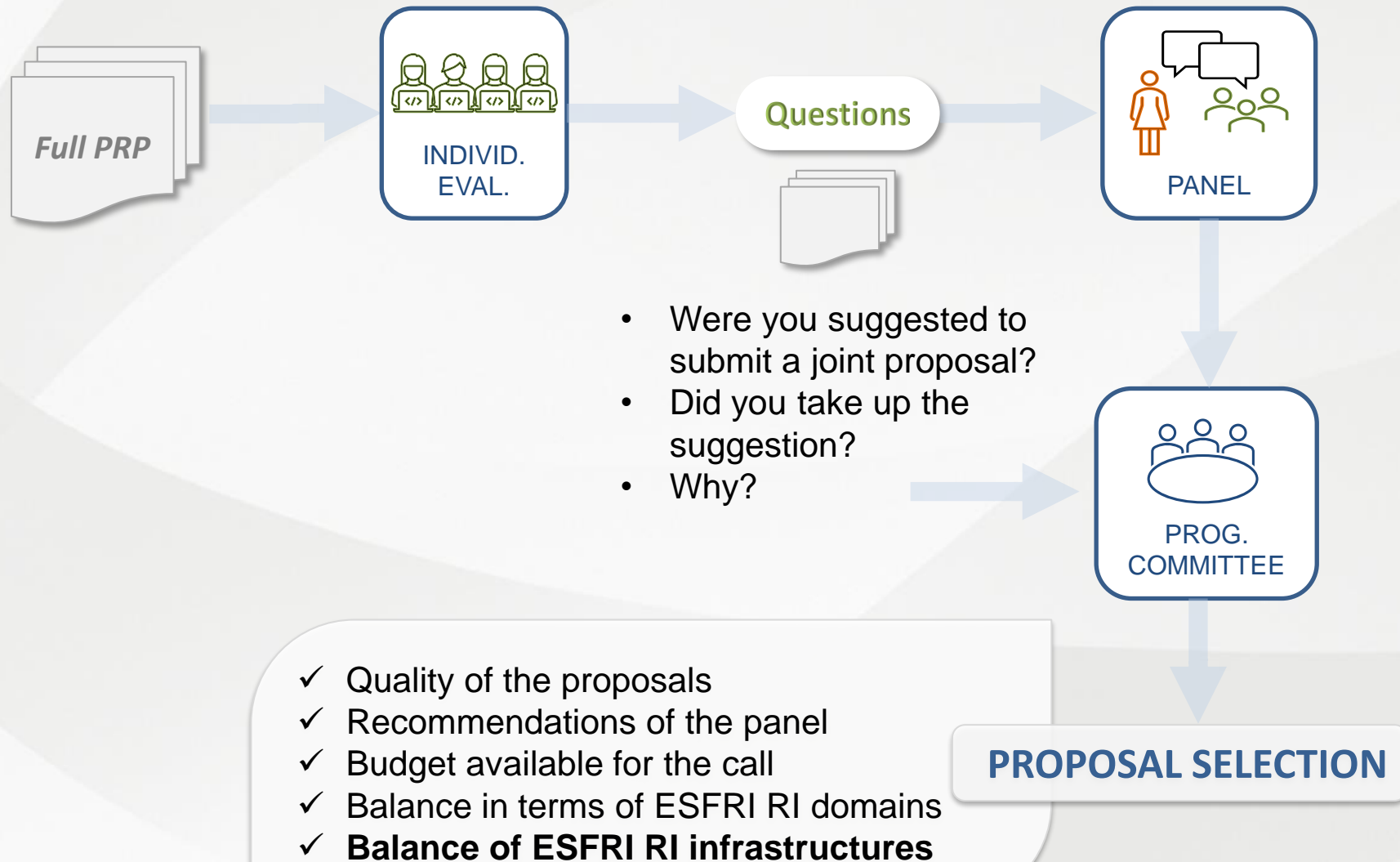
- ✓ Submitting joint full proposal is NOT compulsory
- ✓ Applicants can explain to the Panel why they have (not) followed the recommendations
- ✓ The information will be provided to the Strategic Programme Committee at the selection stage

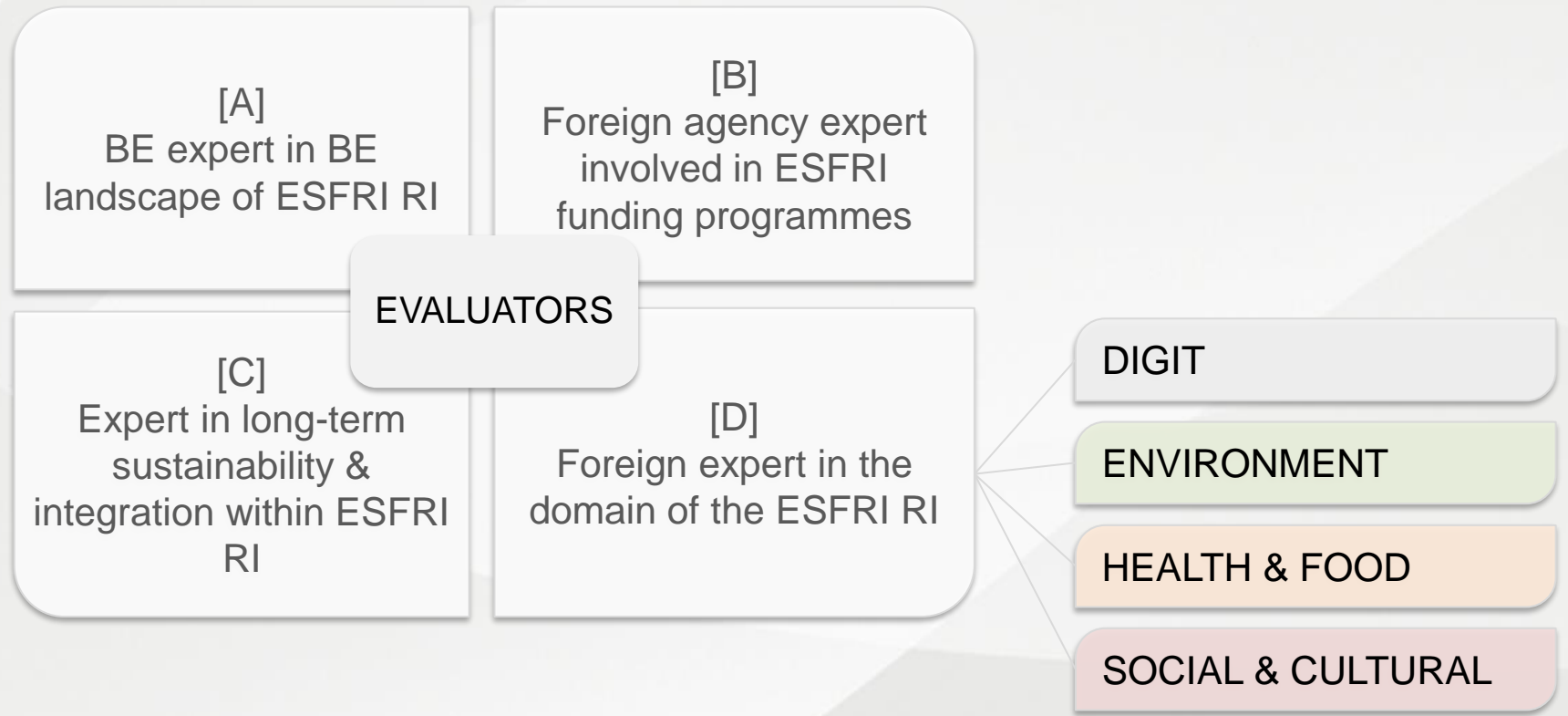
- ✓ May require the introduction of a new EoI

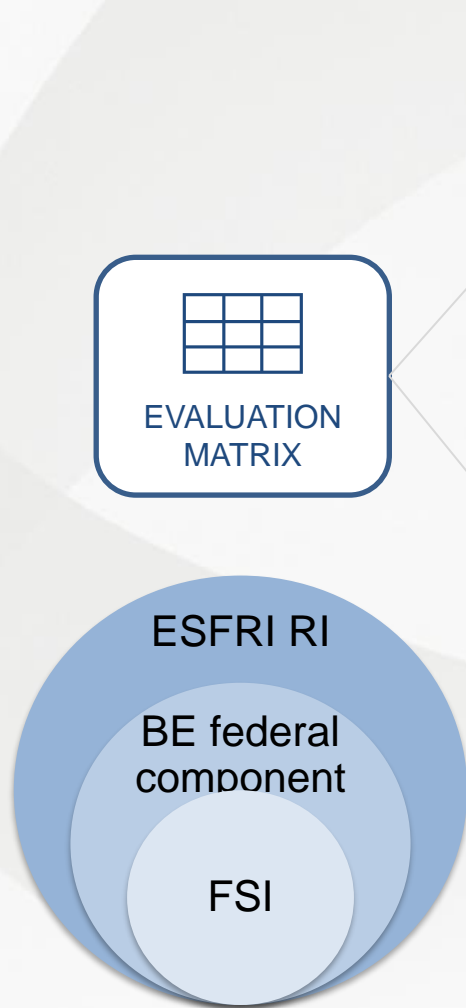

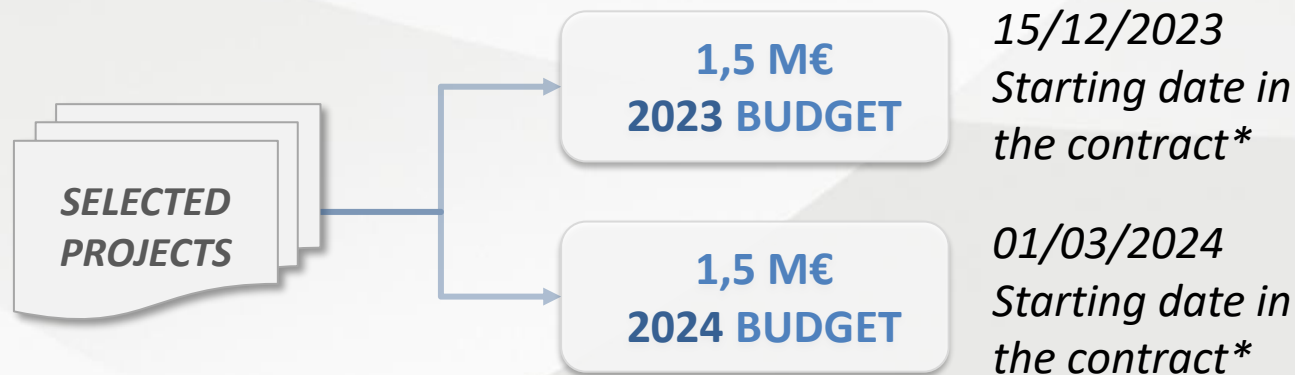
Implementation phase
